- **Adoption Services**

- **BRIDGES Program** – community support program for families with children ages 0 to 8
- **For Teens** – programs for teenagers in foster care, those dropping out of school, and young adults facing homelessness
- **CINS/FINS (Children In Need of Services/Families In Need of Services)** - services for children with behavioral challenges
- **Mentoring** – young people ages 6-21 are matched with adult mentors in their community
- **Counseling**
- **Family Visitation Centers** – supervised visitation for children and adults who have experienced issues including violence and abuse
- **Safe Harbor Emergency** – temporary shelter for youth ages 10-17
- **Teen Outreach Program - development program for teens**
