

Immigrant Family Services - Alachua County Public Schools

Alachua County Public Schools offers services and support programs for eligible immigrant students and families. The term "eligible immigrant student" is defined as a student who:

- (a) is 3-21 years old;
- (b) was not born in any state, Washington, DC or Puerto Rico; (children of military personnel who were born outside these territories are considered immigrant for the purposes of this program)
- (c) has not been attending any one or more schools in the United States for more than 3 full academic years.

Some of the services offered include:

- Acculturation activities (parent workshops, guidance and community outreach)
- Assistance in accessing community resources
- Translation/Interpretation services as feasible
