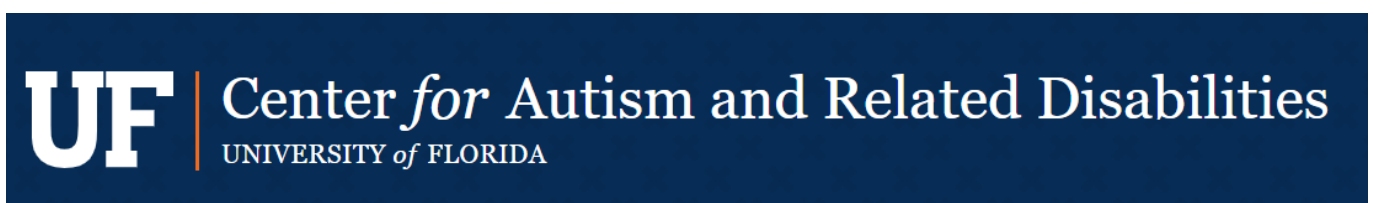
CARD does not provide services such as therapy (such as ABA, OT, PT), ongoing behavioral interventions, diagnosis, respite care, or medical care of any kind.
